




























































Welcome to our show and test garden

Bulbs in public green spaces



In 2018 with a further expansion in 2021, a total of 2400 solar panels were installed on the roof of our business premises. The yield corresponds to the predicted annual usage of our company. With this we have taken a big step towards a carbon (CO₂) neutral production process and since then we are certified with EU Energy Label A.

The important role of bees

There are still a lot of differences between the varieties in terms of the production of nectar and pollen. Location and weather conditions also play an important role. There will be more pollen production on warm, dry days than on rainy days. We marked the varieties that attract bees with a special symbol 4 in our catalogue. Without bees there wouldn't be any flowers, so we are more than happy to foster their habitat.

13. Severance

Should any provision of these general terms and conditions of sale and delivery be non-applicable or in conflict with public order or the law, only the provision in question shall be deemed as not having been written and the rest of the conditions shall remain fully in force. The seller reserves the right to amend the inadmissible provision in order to make it legally valid.

14. Jurisdiction, forum

- 14.1 Any disputes, even if only considered as such by one of the parties, will be put before the competent court in the district in which the seller is registered, without affecting the right of the seller to have the dispute heard by another competent court.
- 14.2 All offers and agreements concluded between the buyer and the seller shall be exclusively governed by the laws of the Netherlands.

Sanctioning countries

- 1. The companies of the CSW group* act in accordance with the European laws and regulations imposed by the OFAC (Chapter 6 of the UN Charter) with regard to sanction countries.
